He received his Bachelor (2003), Master (2005), and Doctor (2010) of Science degrees from Hiroshima University. In 2007, he was adopted as a research associate in Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences at Hiroshima University (Laboratory of Analytical Molecular Medicine and Devices, Professor Tsutomu Masujima), and was a research scientist at QBiC, RIKEN (Laboratory for Single Cell Mass Spectrometry) in 2013. In 2015, he was promoted to a research assistant professor of the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences at The University of Shizuoka (Laboratory of Analytical and Bio-Analytical Chemistry, Professor Toshimasa Toyo'oka).

His current research interests are in the development of novel and high sensitive analytical methods for biomolecule analysis (metabolomics and proteomics, etc.). He was received the Japan Society for Analytical Chemistry Award for Younger Researchers in 2013. And he received 3 Best Poster Presentation Awards. He is an author of over 10 original scientific papers and review articles and 7 book chapters.
