
University Library User Guide

The library is open to visitors who want to access materials that are unavailable at public libraries. If you wish to use the library, please register at the information counter.

A student ID, library card, or user registration card is required to enter the library and to browse through library materials. Please bring one of the above documents when visiting the library.

Library Hours: Monday to Friday: 9:00-22:00

No lecture day: 9:00-17:00

Saturday(only during the semester): 9:00-17:00, 9:00-19:00(during examination period)

Closed: Sundays, National Holidays, University Foundation Day, Year-end and New Year's (12/28 to 1/4),

Other library holidays may be determined by the University Library.

(Please check the Library Calendar)

Borrowing Materials: Please bring the materials you wish to borrow to the information counter along with your student ID (or library user registration card).

Number of materials allowed and period for checkout: 2 weeks for general books, 1 week for assigned books and audiovisual materials; maximum 10 items.

Periodicals (not usually available for checkout); overnight checkout (excluding the latest issue) 16:30 to 10:40 of the following library working day.

- Materials unavailable for checkout: Materials labeled as " in-library use only" (e.g. videos in the audiovisual corner), reference books, periodicals, newspapers, and academic dissertations.
- Renewal: Unless the material is reserved by another user, checked-out material may be renewed only once. Renewal is not permitted for some assigned books.

Returning Materials: Please return materials at the information counter.

When the library is closed, you may return materials in the book-drop at the library entrance.

Do not return audiovisual materials via the book-drop.

Reserving Materials: If the materials you desire are currently checked out, you may reserve up to 5 items.

Online Materials: Computers are available to search online journals and databases.

To Visitors: You must be 18 years or older to use the library (high-school students are not permitted).

- Please bring an identification card (e.g. ID card, driver's license, foreigner registration card). For a full list of acceptable documents, please see the list below. You will also have to fill out a “ User Application for the University of Shizuoka Library” form at the information counter.
- You may check-out up to 3 general books for 2 weeks. (Renewals are not permitted.)
- Audiovisual materials and other materials specified by the chief librarian are not available for check-out.
