# Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) about the International Student Dormitory

## Q. Can I choose my room?

A. No, room selection is not available. Preferences will be considered, but room assignments are determined by the university.

### Q. Can I stay in the dormitory during long breaks such as summer vacation?

A. Yes, residents may stay during long vacations. However, dormitory fees will not be reduced even if you are away (e.g., returning home temporarily).

### Q. Is there a designated lights-out time?

A. There is no specific lights-out time, but to avoid disturbing others, please refrain from making loud noises after 9:00 PM (e.g., slamming doors, loud music, phone calls, alarms, or using hair dryers).

#### Q. Is there a curfew?

A. No, there is no curfew. However, if you return after 9:00 PM, please enter quietly so as not to disturb your unit-mates.

#### Q. Am I allowed to stay overnight elsewhere?

**A.** Yes, overnight stays outside the dormitory are permitted. However, you must submit prior notice, as this information is needed for emergency contact purposes (e.g., in the

event of a natural disaster).

# Q. Can friends or family members visit the dormitory?

**A**. Yes, visitors are allowed with prior notice and submission of a request. Meetings should be held in the shared common areas.

### Q. When does dormitory rent start to apply?

A. Dormitory fees begin from the month of enrollment (April or October).

In principle, residents are required to move in on the designated move-in date. Even if a resident moves in later due to personal reasons, no reduction in dormitory fees will be given.

# Q. How do I pay the dormitory fee?

A. Payments should be made via bank transfer by the designated due date, on a persemester basis.

# Q. Can I bring a bicycle or motorbike?

A. Yes, both are allowed.

#### Q. How should I receive frozen or refrigerated deliveries?

A. Since frozen/refrigerated items cannot be delivered to parcel lockers, please schedule deliveries for times when you can receive them in person.

- Q. What should I do if I accidentally damage dormitory equipment or furniture?
- A. Please report it and arrange to replace the item with one of equal value.
- Q. I would like to be away for about two weeks for training. Is this allowed?
- **A.** As the dormitory is intended for international exchange, absences of two weeks or more are generally not permitted.
- Q. What countries have the dormitory residents come from in the past?
- A. The nationalities and number of residents vary by year, but past residents have come from 15 countries: Russia, the Philippines, Malaysia, Germany, Turkey, Laos, Cambodia, Algeria, India, China, South Korea, Myanmar, France, Spain and Japan.

# Q. Do I need to prepare bedding?

A. You may either prepare your own bedding or use the rental service.

[Bedding Rental]

Included: Mattress pad, winter comforter, summer comforter, blanket, pillow, two sheets, duvet cover, pillow cover

Replacement: Sheets, duvet covers, and pillow covers are replaced twice per month on scheduled dates

\*Fees (as of 2025):

• 3 months: ¥6,930

• 6 months: ¥11,880

• 12 months: ¥19,800

Q. I want to purchase bedding. What are the dimensions of the dormitory bed?

A. The bed size is 100 cm x 195 cm.

Q. Do I need to purchase fire and tenant liability insurance?

A. Yes, insurance is required.
